

## **SOUTHWEST WOODCARVERS PEOPLE'S CHOICE SHOW SHOW LOGISTICS AND OPERATION**

- 1 The show committee will receive the entries, by 10:00 AM on the first day, to be placed upon the People's Choice Table assuring the carving is assigned to the correct category, if it is offered for sale, and that the carver agrees to abide by the show rules.**
- 2. The Club will provide at least three tables that will be arranged to display the carvings in the proper categories.**
- 3. The public will vote for their favorite carving in each of the seven show categories using a simple ballot form provided to them by Committee volunteers. Tabulation of results by the Committee will determine which carvings will receive awards in each of the categories and subcategories. The following is a list of how the awards are to awarded in each Category, Sub-Category, Carvers Choice, and Peoples Choice.**
  - a. Two or three entries in a Category or Sub-Category will only receive a First Place Award.**
  - b. Four or more entries in a Category or Sub-Category will receive First thru Third place Awards**
  - c. Peoples Choice Awards will be given First thru Third**
  - d. Carvers Choice Awards will be given First thru Third**
- 4. The public will be allowed one voting form per person. Children are allowed to vote as long as they are accompanied by a parent. Voting will take place only on the first day of the show ending at 5:00 p.m.**
- 5. Final tabulation of votes by the Committee will be accomplished by the end of the first day of the show. If there is a tie, both carvings will be awarded a Award. The committee's decision may be contested to the Board of Directors prior to the placement of the awards on the morning of the second day. Ribbons will be placed on winning carvings upon opening the second day of the show.**
- 6.a. Individual carvers may purchase tables for carving demonstration, sale of their carvings and display of their carvings during the show. Tables must be arranged for and paid in full BEFORE the first day of the show.**  
**6.b. Tables may be sold to carving vendors for the sale of carving tools and material.**
- 7. Carvers are encouraged to demonstrate carving at their table and to greet the public informing them of their carvings and what they are demonstrating.**
- 8. The Committee will manage all raffles and establish a membership contact/table for possible interested new members.**
